

## **Directions to Kenneth B. George Park, Riverside Way, River Edge, NJ**

### **FROM THE NORTH**

Kinderkamack Road South to Tenney Ave. (1 block south of the traffic light at Continental Avenue - there is a Chase Manhattan Bank on the far left corner and the Fire House and Borough Hall are on your right). Turn left onto Tenney and follow around the bend (becomes Riverside Way), over the tracks into the park.

### **FROM THE SOUTH**

From Route 4 Eastbound (Paramus area): Pass Spring Valley Road and Forest Ave. exits. Take next exit for "River Edge". Continue straight on exit ramp "River Edge, Local Roads" to the U-Turn sign - turn right at the U-Turn exit and follow the U-Turn signs - 2 left turns will put you on Kinderkamack Road. Continue straight on Kinderkamack Road North approximately 1.4 miles to Tenney Ave. (Fire House and Borough Hall on the left, Chase Manhattan Bank on the near right corner). Turn right onto Tenney and follow around the bend (becomes Riverside Way), over the tracks into the park.

### **FROM THE EAST**

From Route 4 Westbound: Go through Englewood, Teaneck. Cross over Hackensack River, pass exits for Hackensack Avenue. Take the very next exit (may be marked Kinderkamack or Grand, or maybe Ackerson!). Merge right onto Grand, and make the first left onto Kinderkamack (if you miss that exit, the very next one - off the service road - will put you right onto Grand - turn left onto Kinderkamack). Continue on Kinderkamack for approximately 1.4 miles to Tenney Ave. (Fire House and Borough Hall on the left, Chase Manhattan Bank on the near right corner). Turn right onto Tenney and follow around the bend (becomes Riverside Way), over the tracks into the park.

### **FROM THE WEST**

Take either Midland Avenue or Continental Ave. east to the end and turn right on Kinderkamack Road and follow to Tenney Ave (1 block south of the traffic light at Continental Avenue - there is a Chase Manhattan Bank on the far left corner and the Fire House and Borough Hall are on your right). Turn left onto Tenney and follow around the bend (becomes Riverside Way), over the tracks into the park.
